



FINGERPRINTING SERVICES AVAILABLE

I am pleased to announce that through the generous support and donations of the New Oxford Social & Athletic Club, the Gettysburg Fraternal Order of Eagles, the McSherrystown Loyal Order of the Moose and the McSherrystown Home Association, the Adams County Sheriff's Office was able to acquire a Live Scan Fingerprinting machine at no cost to the tax payers. The machine has been delivered and my staff is now been trained in its use.

The primary use for this new technology will be to allow county residents needing to obtain legally-mandated fingerprinting required in background checks for those individual seeking employment in such occupations as child care services and education. These services are not routinely provided by many of the county's police departments. Those, like the Pennsylvania State Police, that do provide this service limit the times they are available to the public.

This generous donation will now allow the Sheriff's Office to provide yet another location where county residents can be provided with this free service. Beginning on **Wednesday, January 29, 2014**, the public may come to the Sheriff's Office located in the Adams County Court House, 117 Baltimore Street, Room 4, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania to be fingerprinted. We will make this service available on **Wednesdays from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM** and **Fridays, from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM.**
